| Cultural Team <br> Leadership <br> Essay | $20 \%$ | Write a 10-page essay <br> (2500-3000 words) about <br> what it takes to be an effective <br> team leader within an <br> organization's culture, such as <br> Google or Starbuck's. You can <br> talk about the necessary traits, <br> values, how conflict should be <br> handled, <br> expectations/priorities of the <br> organization, etc.: any aspect <br> of team leadership that can <br> affect the effectiveness of a <br> team within that culture. At <br> least 10 sources must be used. <br> The essay should be in MLA <br> format. |  |


| Case Studies | $20 \%$ | Write two case studies <br> (500-1000 words each) based <br> on one or more of the required <br> readings. Case studies should <br> describe a situation in which <br> the content of a reading is <br> important to understand that <br> situation more deeply. Each <br> case study should include 3-4 <br> questions about it, and the <br> answers to the questions <br> should require discussion of <br> each reading's content. | April 14 |

| Team <br> Leadership <br> Strengths and <br> Weakness | $10 \%$ | Write a 800-1000-word essay <br> about your <br> approach/philosophy to team <br> membership/leadership. Also, talk about your <br> strengths and weaknesses, <br> how they will affect you while <br> on a team, and what you will <br> do to ensure you use them to <br> be the most effective team <br> leader/member possible | April 21 |
| Film Analysis | $20 \%$ | This 8-10 page (2000-2500 <br> words) essay will analyze the <br> team leadership in a recent <br> film using the content in the <br> readings as its framework. |  |
